DOWNLOAD YOUR TICKETS

Print or pre-download your tickets prior to arriving at the venue to avoid delays at entry.

If your ticket is on your phone, screenshot it before arriving at the gates.

Turn up the brightness on your phone to maximum setting for fast scanning. If your screen is damaged, please print your ticket.

STAY HYDRATED

Bring an empty plastic bottle to fill with water at the multiple free water stations. These will be around the bars. There are also bottled water and soft drinks available for purchase at the bars as well.

TAKE REGULAR BREAKS

Find a space to enjoy some chill out time and rest throughout the duration of the festival.

FUEL YOUR BODY

Keep your energy levels up by enjoying some of the delicious food options available from our vendors.

PREPARE FOR ALL WEATHER CONDITIONS

Mercury Baypark is an uncovered venue. We recommend preparing for all conditions on the day, including having raincoats or ponchos for the rain.

For sunny conditions, 'slip, slop, slap and wrap' to protect your skin and eyes. Slip on weather-appropriate clothing, slop on sunscreen, slap on a hat and wrap on sunglasses

TAKE CARE

Take care before, during and after Juicy Fest.

Be safe, be responsible and look out for those around you.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

FREE Buses have been arranged to and from Juicy Fest.

**Buses will depart from and return to the following locations:
Blake Park, Mount Sports Centre Bus Stop, Maunganui Rd
opposite Clyde St.**

**Gordon Spratt Reserve Carpark, end of Alice Lane,
Parton Rd, Pāpāmoa.**

Bus Stop Stand D, Wharf St, Tauranga CBD.

Pick-ups will run between 11:30am-3pm.

**Drop-offs start at 9.30pm and depart from the Mercury Baypark
car park.**

**Follow the signs to the front of the arena.
Please be patient - there may be delays while buses are loaded
or looping back to the venue after a drop-off.**

ROAD CLOSURES & TRAVEL TIPS

There is no access to Mercury Baypark.

Truman Lane will be closed at the Te Maunga Interchange (SH29A) from 9am Sunday, 7 January to 1am Monday, 8 January.

Only festival buses, Truman Lane businesses, and residents visiting the Te Maunga transfer station, will be able to access Truman Lane via Mangatawa Link Road/Sandhurst Rd.

The road will be reduced to one lane with stop-go management providing access to festival buses and residents as required.

There will be a lot of people walking between Arataki and Mercury Baypark, with extensive traffic management in place to ensure their safety.

Motorists should avoid travelling at peak festival start and finish times or take an alternative route if possible. If you need to travel through these areas, please drive carefully and expect delays.

There is no drop-off/pick-up zone at Mercury Baypark. A public drop-off zone is available at the on Truman Lane via Mangatawa Link Rd.

PARKING

Parking is not available on-site at Mercury Baypark.

MOBILITY PARKING

Dedicated mobility parking can be booked by contacting event@juicyfest.co.nz.

This parking is strictly for mobility parking permit holders and a valid permit must be displayed on the vehicle window on arrival at the venue.

These are available on a strict first-come, first-served basis.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

EXPECTATIONS OF ATTENDEES

Aged 18+ and have valid ID (Passport, NZ Driver Licence, Kiwi Access Card only).

Hold a legitimate ticket purchased from an authorised seller.

Not currently trespasses from the venue.

Allow authorised staff to search possessions for prohibited items.

Wear footwear at all times.

Do not display gang insignia.

Anyone who refuses the searches, appears intoxicated, is under the influence of drugs, exhibits disorderly behaviour, or holds illegitimate tickets may be denied entry, asked to leave the venue and/or be trespasses.

*Prohibited items will be confiscated and will not be returned. Conditions are subject to change without notice.

EXPECTATIONS OF ATTENDEES

Do not behave in an unacceptable or disruptive manner.

Do not take part in dangerous activities such as aggressive moshing, crowd surfing and climbing.

Understand bringing personal items into the festival is at owner's risk.

Understand pass outs are not issued for the festival.

No leaving or attempting to leave festival grounds with alcohol.

Do not smoke cigarettes, e-cigarettes or vapes.

Do not take part in unsolicited selling of merch, ads, promotional giveaways, or unauthorised soliciting or customer surveys.

Comply with directions from event staff, security or the NZ Police.

*Failure to meet expectations could result in the removal from the event, arrest, fines or prosecution.

MERCURY BAYPARK CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

SECURITY & SEARCHES ON ENTRY

Festival Management and its representatives reserve the right to request patrons to present any clothing, bags and other carried items for searching, including being subject to a pat down security search and/or a scanner search before entering the stadium.

If you refuse to present any of the requested items for searching, you will be denied entry.

DRUG & ALCOHOL POLICY

Juicy Festival complies with the Liquor Licensing Authority and prohibits the serving of alcohol to intoxicated or under-aged persons.

Those who arrive at the gates intoxicated will be refused entry into the event, and patrons who become intoxicated will be escorted from the venue.

Juicy Festival maintains a strict 'no drugs' policy.

Any persons found with drugs will have them confiscated and be escorted from the premises.

Incidents involving alcohol or drugs will be referred to the NZ Police as required.
